WHO WE ARE:

COMMUNITIES IN SCHOOLS (CIS) IS THE NATION'S LARGEST DROPOUT PREVENTION ORGANIZATION. CIS PROVIDES OR COORDINATES SERVICES THAT ADDRESS THE UNDERLYING REASONS WHY STUDENTS LEAVE SCHOOLS WITHOUT A DIPLOMA. CIS IMPLEMENTS A COMMUNITY-BASED INTEGRATED STUDENT SERVICES STRATEGY, LEVERAGING COMMUNITY RESOURCES WHERE THEY ARE MOST NEEDED—IN SCHOOLS.

WHAT WE DO:

BY BRINGING CARING ADULTS INTO THE SCHOOLS TO ADDRESS CHILDREN'S UNMET NEEDS, CIS PROVIDES THE LINK BETWEEN EDUCATORS AND THE COMMUNITY. THE RESULT, TEACHERS ARE FREE TO TEACH AND STUDENTS—MANY IN JEOPARDY OF DROPPING OUT—HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO FOCUS ON LEARNING.

PROGRAMS:

FIRSTSCHOOL GARDENS—GARDENS ARE LAID OUT, PLANTED AND MAINTAINED BY STUDENTS AND PARENTS AT MOORE COUNTY SCHOOLS. THE GARDENS ARE USED DURING THE SCHOOL YEAR FOR LESSONS RANGING FROM SCIENCE TO HISTORY TO SUSTAINABILITY. OUR GARDENS ARE BEING USED AS MODELS FOR SCHOOL GARDENS ACROSS NORTH CAROLINA.

SOS PROGRAM—CIS PARTNERED WITH THE TOWN OF ABERDEEN PARKS AND RECREATION DEPARTMENT AND CREATED THE SOS AFTER SCHOOL PROGRAM FOR STUDENTS FROM SOUTHERN MIDDLE SCHOOL AND ABERDEEN ELEMENTARY SCHOOL. THE PROGRAM IS HELD AT THE ABERDEEN RECREATION STATION, MONDAY THROUGH THURSDAY FROM 3PM-6PM.
